

WALK JACKSON 2019

How to **Walk Jackson**:

- Walk your Ward. Or, the equivalent miles of the streets in your Ward.
- Walk more Wards. Or, the equivalent miles of the streets in other Wards.
- Walk the Town. Or, the equivalent miles of the streets in Jackson.

Why **Walk Jackson**?

- Learn the Ward you live in.
- Learn the other Wards in Jackson.
- Discover the streets in your ward.
- See parts of town you've never seen before. (And discover things you've never seen while driving through familiar parts of town.)
- Meet your neighbors. (And by the way, Jackson is small enough that we're all neighbors.)

Why kick **Walk Jackson** off during Public Works Week?

- To promote Public Works, and ask participants to look out for Public Works while walking.

How can **Walk Jackson** walkers help Public Works?

- Be on the watch for street signs that are missing, street lights not burning at night (or burning during the day when they shouldn't), storm sewers that are clogged, manhole lids out of place, or anything that may affect the City Water, Wastewater, Street, Storm Water, or Electric Utilities.
- Report damage to City Property such as parks, restrooms, retaining walls, or pavilions.

How many miles are there in a Ward?

- Ward 1 = 25.1 miles
- Ward 2 = 48.1 miles
- Ward 3 = 29.4 miles
- Ward 4 = 30.8 miles
